School buildings are open for staff access (as mandated by state or local agencies.) Hybrid approach for “high-risk” groups including: Students w/ disabilities, living homeless, farthest from educational justice (includes no internet access) and younger learners (PK-3) may participate onsite, in groups (5 or less) with limited in-person instruction. COVID precautions in place	All extracurricular in-person activities, including sports, performances, clubs, events, are canceled or postponed
3 PHASE ONE REOPEN	County incidence of COVID 19 is <75 cases /100K/14 days for 2 consecutive weeks. Other considerations: No campus outbreaks occur	Hybrid approach for ALL PK-5; 6-12 high-risk groups in-person (5 or less) in classrooms w/ limited instruction. COVID precautions in place	Possible limited participation in extracurricular, in-person activities Consider low risk activities
4 PHASE TWO REOPEN (A/B Split Model)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Local viral trends improve with a lower level of community transmission (25-49 cases per 100k over 14 days) Determination made in consultation with local health officials 	Full-time, in person learning for ALL PK-5 and hybrid, A/B learning schedule for ALL 6-12	Consider increased participation for low and moderate risk in person extracurricular activities, including WIAA approved sports seasons
5 FULL REOPEN	Incidence of <25/100K/14 days for 2 consecutive weeks. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Possible vaccine 	Full day learning experience for ALL PK-12 COVID precautions in place	Possible full-participation for extracurricular activities, including WIAA approved sports seasons
